

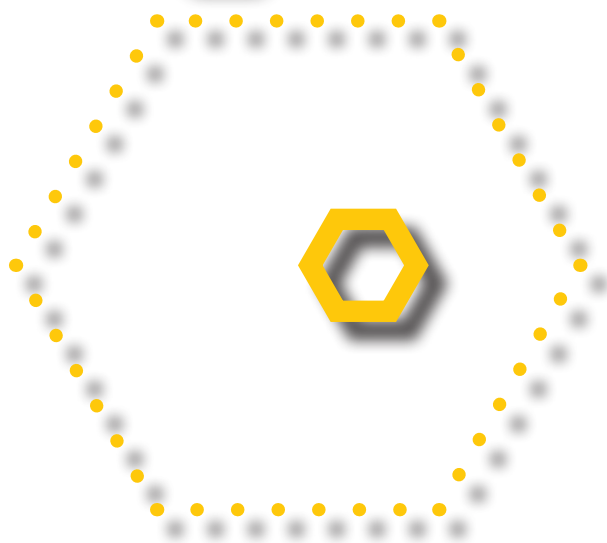

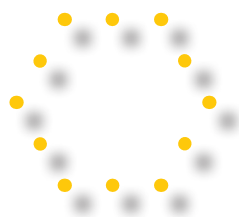

Today's generation is realizing the importance of receiving higher education as it not only strengthens the social character but also helps to explore better career prospects and ensures better paying jobs. The Salesians of Don Bosco at DBTI, Okhla, realized this to the full and hence decided to go for a Higher Education Institute. The Management of DBTI Okhla is extremely grateful to His Grace Anil Joseph Thomas Couto, the Archbishop of Delhi who gave immense support when the affiliation process was taking its shape.

Starting of a college takes commitment and effective planning from the concerned management. Fr. C. A. Joseph sdb who was the Director of the Institute then,

Br. Cyriac Kurias sdb who is the administrator of the Institute and Br. Tom C. J., the Principal of Institute put their heads together and planned meticulously to apply for a college. Mrs. Ruchi Sawhney who is one of the staffs of the computer section put her heart and soul in getting all the details and following up all the necessary paper work. After considerable planning for a couple of years, application for the affiliation of college in view of starting BCA course, was submitted to GGSIP University as well as to the Directorate of Higher Education, on 24th April, 2019. After the necessary screening of the documents, the university authorities were obliging and were fast with the inspection process. Meanwhile we had fulfilled the necessary requirements like fire alarms, fire extinguishers, additional stair case in case of fire, well equipped computer lab, library and so on. Inspection took place on 14th June, 2019 and the inspection team of three were impressed with the facilities of the campus. In fact, they helped us with suggestions

for improvement as well as gave directions to take the college forward in the right direction.

We managed to fulfil the recommendations given by the team of inspectors and we had to wait quite long for an answer from the university. Mean while we had to make a number of visits to the affiliation department in case they required any further clarification. Though the entire process was delayed, finally, it was a dream coming true in fact, when we received the NOC on 19th July, 2019. Later on, the provisional affiliation was granted to Bosco Technical Training Society (College) by the GGIP University on 6th January, 2020.

Once the NOC was obtained, it was tough indeed to get the candidates for the college, Bosco Technical Training Society. With the hard work, the management was able to get 30 students though five of them dropped out a little later. Finally, the number of students for the first batch of BCA was formed, a group of young and energetic students consists of twenty-one boys and four girls. The following faculties were appointed as Assistant Professors; Mrs. Ruchi Sawhney, Mrs. Deepika Kirti and Mr. Bijoy Jose. The official inauguration of the BCA course was on 16th August, 2019 on the occasion of the 204th birth anniversary of Don Bosco who is the father and founder of the Salesian congregation. At a

later stage we had an interview for the Director for the affiliated course. After interview and necessary consultation, Dr. Vikas Rao Vadi, a dynamic person indeed, was unanimously chosen and appointed on 16th September, 2019 as the first Director of the GGSIPU courses. He is well experienced and has good knowledge on running a college. He is committed and willing to walk an extra mile whenever it is needed for the betterment of the college. Under his able direction, the college is growing fast. In fact, during the time of admission for the second batch, it was already lockdown due to the prevailing coronavirus all over the country. But under his able leadership and dynamism together with the committed staff, the admission to the second batch of BCA was full to its capacity of sixty in 2020. Hats off to the team for the wonderful achievement.

Considering the facts, it is challenging indeed today, to run and manage a college competently. The college authorities need to put their heads together and engage in management and leadership activities to take the college to the right direction. Change is inevitable. And given the technological changes occurring in today's world, those responsible will need to plan and make decisions to keep moving forward at an ever-increasing pace.

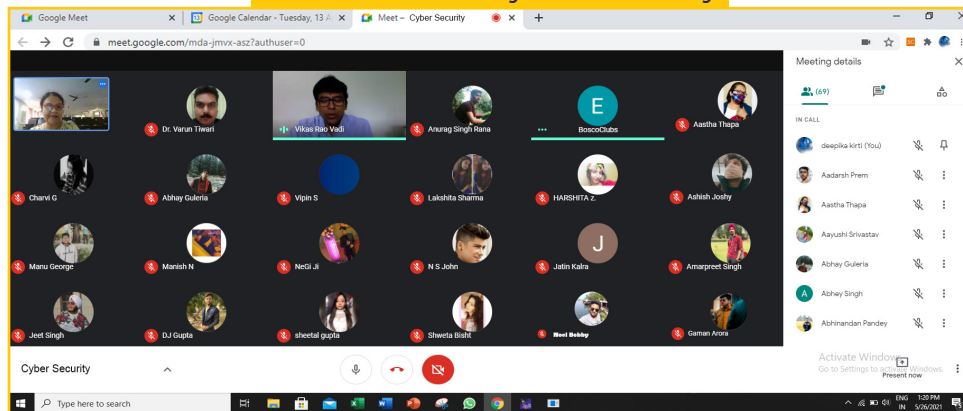

CYBER SECURITY

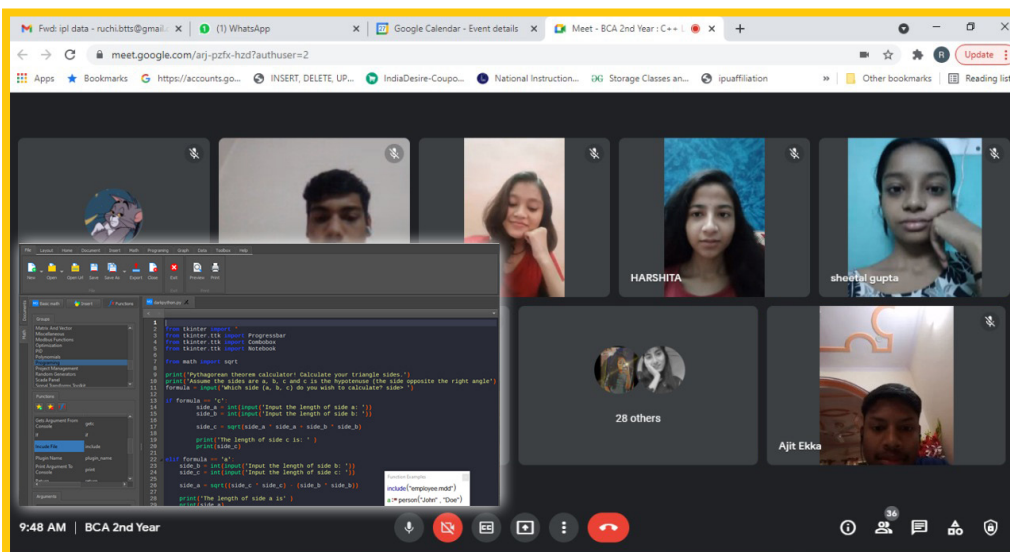

SEMINAR ON "PYTHON"

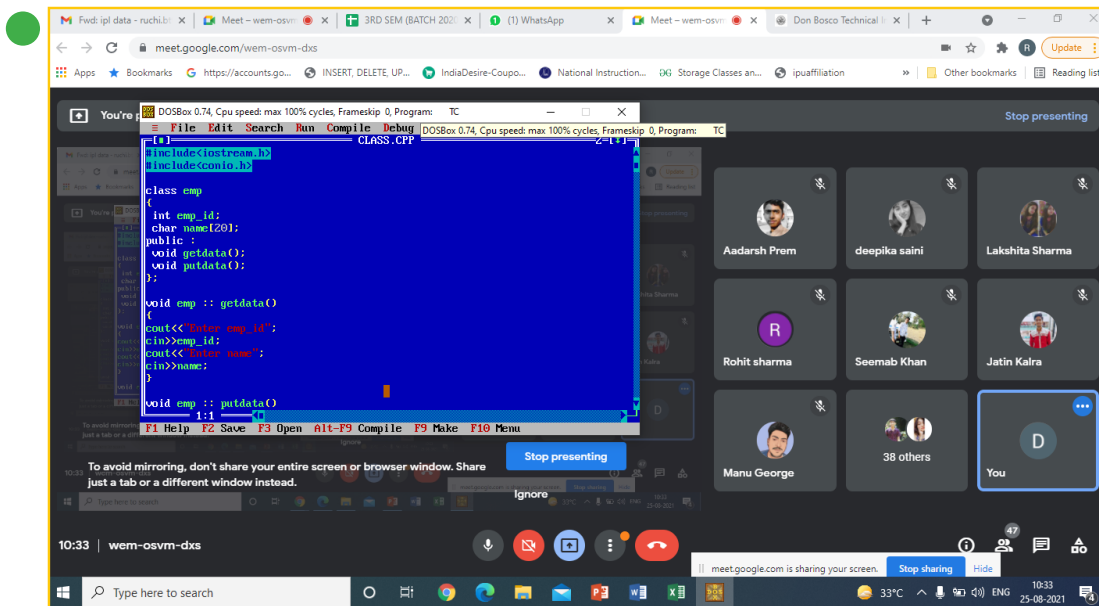

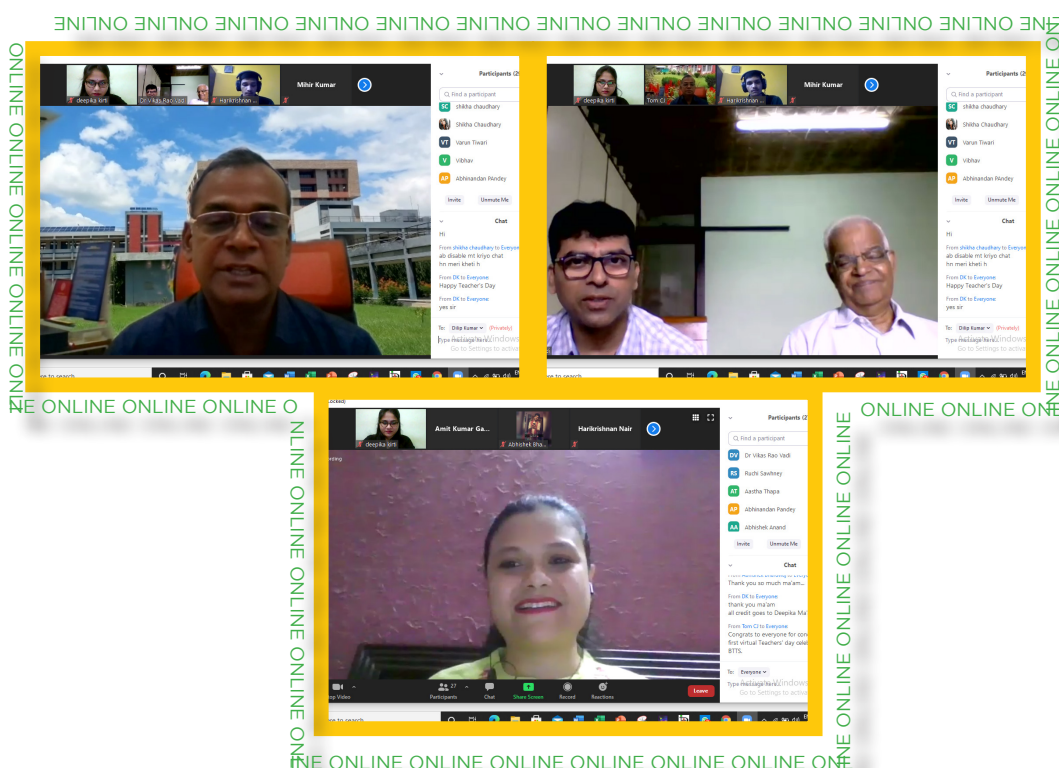

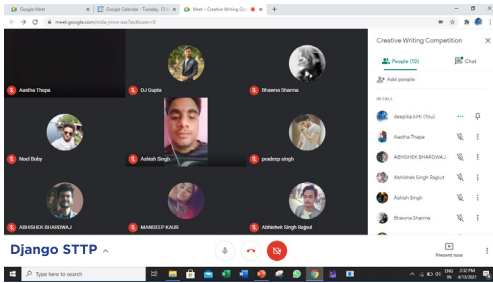
TEACHERS' DAY

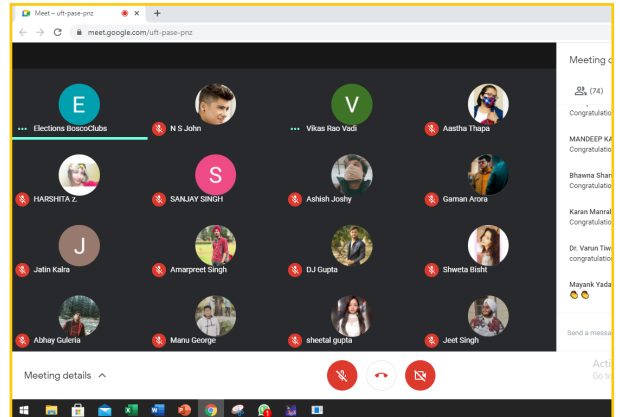

SANDARBH QUIZ COMPETITION

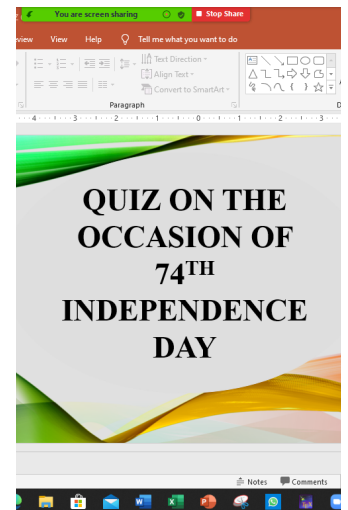

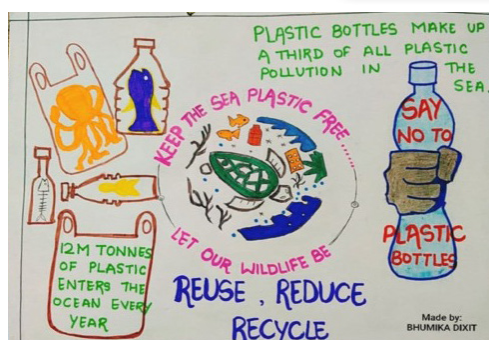

We hope his hard work and enthusiasm to do better, make our emerging institution to become the best institution – an Institution with a difference.



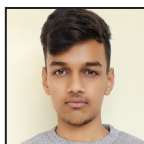
CLUBS ELECTIONS

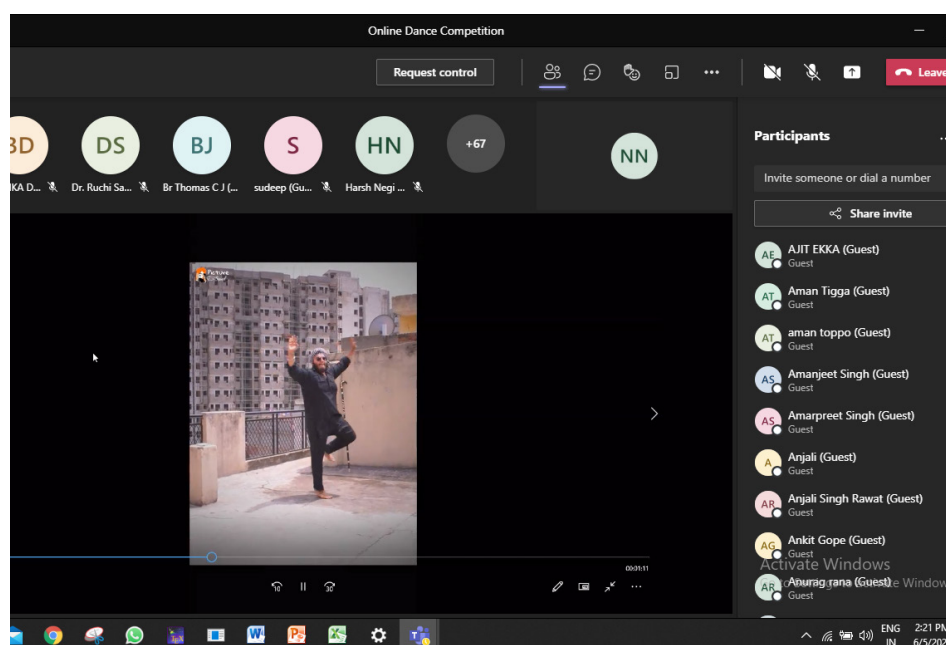
“unable to login” flooded their WhatsApp accounts. Even after the mountains of challenges, the election was smoothly and securely held.

DANCE COMPETITION



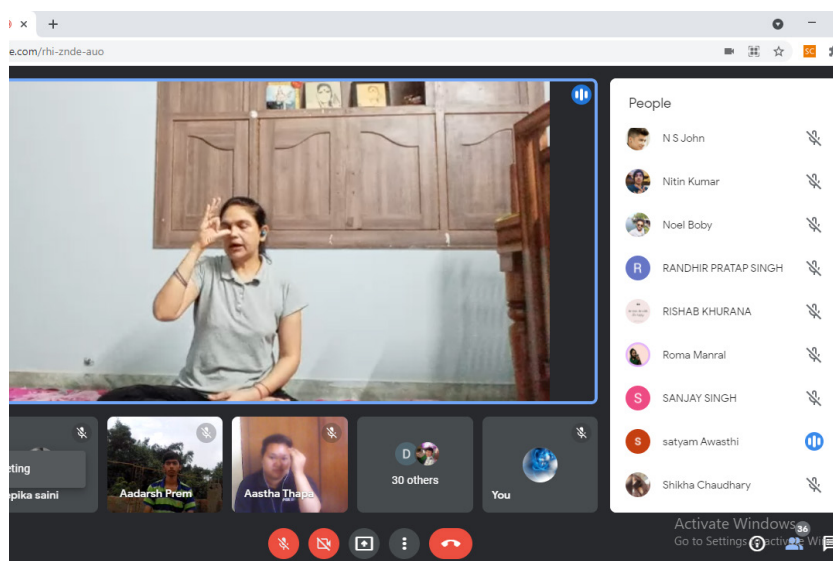
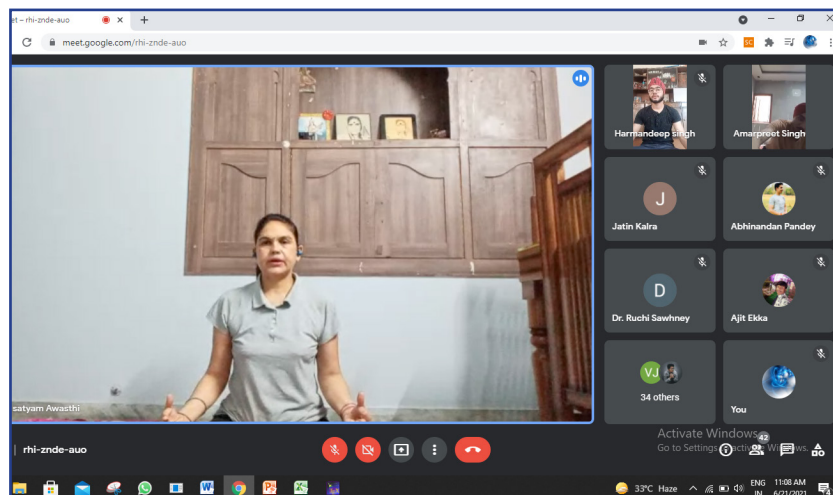

How to do well in Personal Interviews

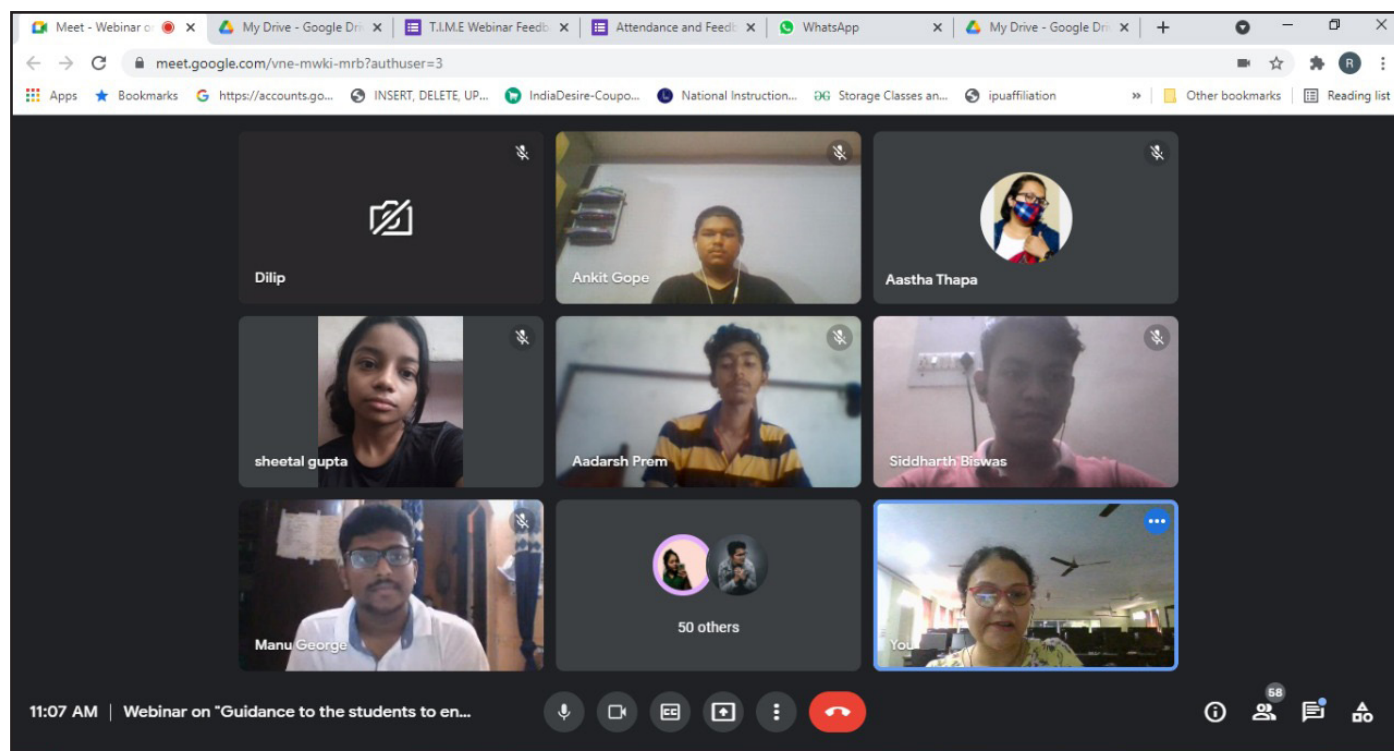
